It was almost immediately after I noticed he was gone, that he returned and came to me with a towel and a hand-written note. It read —



"I get a strong sense that you're struggling with something. Please consider using this towel tonight. You can give your life to Him."

As if I hadn't been crying enough, I burst into tears. Lisa asked if I was going to do it. Through my tears I said "Yes! But where do I go?" She embraced me and told me she loved me. Jim then led me to Pastor Robyn, who prayed over me and pointed me in the direction of the tank. I was then met by Kelly Fernandes who cried when I told her what had just happened and, again, prayed over me. I then joined Pastor Steve and Pastor Mark in the tank, and was baptized in the name of my God. My life has been on a never-ending high since then. Even my bad days don't seem so gray."


